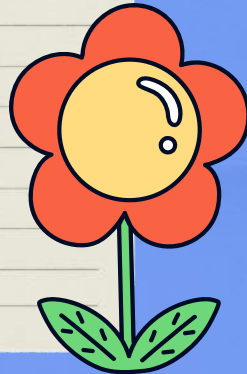

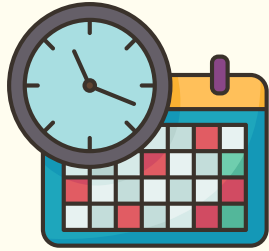

Principal and Teachers addressing the meeting with parents





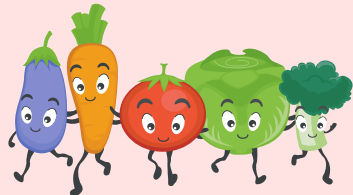
Food Habits

Importance of green vegetables and protein-rich food was brought up.



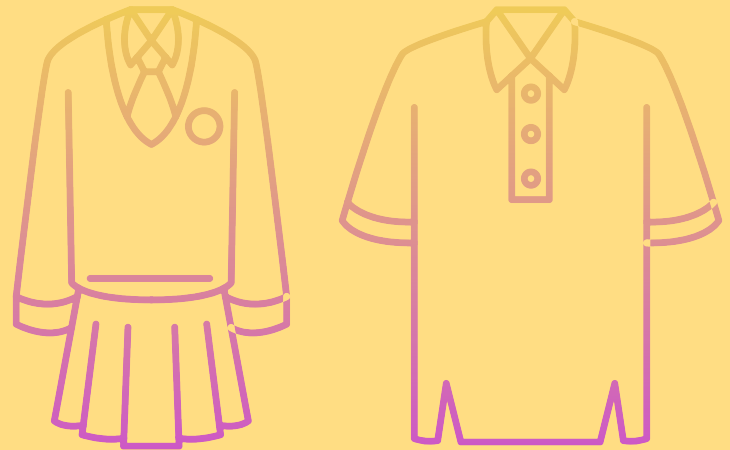

Importance of school uniform has been highlighted. We believe in the fact that a uniform develops a sense of belonging and promotes the school spirit.





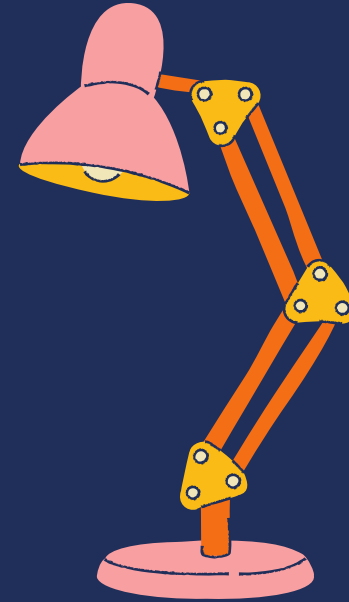
Academics
